

The Thursday Friendship Group

Will be Meeting at Welham Hall 10.00 until 12.00

Every Thursday morning beginning Thursday 25th January 2018

The purpose of this group is to provide a safe, friendly meeting place where those alone or feeling lonely can meet together with other mature adults.

Although there will be no proscribed agenda or age limit (over 30 is suggested but is will be flexible).

We suggest that this is a group who will develop their own agenda and activities with the purpose of finding friendships that are mutually beneficial.

The Grantham & District Senior Citizens will facilitate the meeting initially in their new building for which there will be a small charge of £1.00 per person for each meeting to cover the cost of running this Community building.

Attendees will have the option of staying for a pre ordered 2 course meals provided by TESS the training organisation who manage the kitchen , if required.

Meals are available for order up to Tuesday midday at a cost of £4.00 approx per head. Whilst there is no obligation to participate all will be welcome.

During the Summer months outings are arranged by the Club, seats can also be made available for the friendship group if required.

If you are interested just pop in any Thursday morning where a warm welcome will be extended to all.

Help assistance and referrals to all support agencies can be organised as required, The Senior Citizens are directly involved with Healthwatch,

The Dementia Voluntary Support Group, CVS , Community Lincs, SKDC and other voluntary agencies to name a few.

This Group is an independent voluntary effort and will not be funded by any official County Council Authority or Local Government money's in it's initial stages, and the future will be directed by the group in consultation with the Senior Citizens and TESS.
